

Reserved Names Activation Procedure (February 28, 2014)

Eligible institutions and bodies wishing to register .SAARLAND domain names placed on the reserved list for their exclusive use in accordance with Section 2a) of the Blocked And Reserved Names Policy are invited to apply for the reserved domain name by following this procedure.

1) The applicant will receive an individual token for application for the reserved name from the office, agency or officer designated by the state government for the release of Reserved Names before the general availability starts. For any queries, do not hesitate to contact the Saarland Ministry for Economic Affairs, Labour, Energy and Traffic ("Ministerium für Wirtschaft, Arbeit, Energie und Verkehr") (E-Mail: dotsaarland@wirtschaft.saarland.de).

2) The applicant shall contact an accredited .SAARLAND registrar with one's request for release of the reserved domain name, and provide the appropriate token and a full set of whois data for the applicant to be used in the registration.

3) The registrar submits a request to release the reserved name to the Registry at reserved@nic.saarland.

4) The Registry shall inform the office, agency or officer designated by the state government for the release of Reserved Names about all application requests.

5) Unless the request is countermanded by the state government within 14 days after the information is provided by the Registry, the Registry shall coordinate the release of the Reserved Name to the applicant with the registrar.
